On June 11, 2020, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing (“Board”) issued a Final Decision and Order (“Order”) limiting Respondent’s professional nursing license with certain terms and conditions including, but not limited to, completion of an assessment by an approved mental health provider experienced in evaluating health care practitioners’ fitness for duty. The Order further states that Respondent’s license shall be limited in a manner to address any concerns the Board has with the conduct set out in the Order’s findings of fact and to address any recommendations resulting from the assessment.

On May 13, 2021, the Board reviewed and accepted the report resulting from Respondent’s fitness for duty assessment. Based on the assessor’s recommendations, the following is entered:

ORDER

1. Respondent’s professional nursing license (#199449-30) is further LIMITED as follows:

a. Respondent shall arrange for her employer to provide work reports to the department monitor on a quarterly basis, beginning with the 2nd quarter of 2021, for a period of one year. Respondent may request termination of this requirement after four (4) quarterly work reports have been received.
