On September 15, 2020, the Wisconsin Social Worker Section of the Marriage and Family Therapy, Professional Counseling, and Social Work Examining Board issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") requiring Respondent to complete six (6) hours of education in boundaries and dual relationships within 90 days and nineteen (19) hours of continuing education, including four (4) hours in ethics and boundaries within 180 days. The information of record demonstrates that Respondent has failed to comply with the education requirements and as a result the following is entered:

1. Respondent's certificate to practice social work (certificate number 6182-120) is hereby SUSPENDED.
2. The suspension shall remain in effect until Respondent has demonstrated successful completion of the education requirements of the Order.
