On November 10, 2020, the Wisconsin Real Estate Appraisers Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's licensed appraiser certificate of licensure. Respondent was required to complete National USPAP course (15 hours), Basic Appraisal Procedures (30 hours), and Appraiser Self Protection: Documentation and Record Keeping (4 hours) pursuant to the terms of the Order.
