On December 3, 2020, the Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's license to practice pharmacy. Respondent was required to complete twelve (12) hours of education on the topic of patient safety and medication errors, best practices for managing pharmacist and/or pharmacist in charge, and pharmacist responsibilities in the dispensing and management of controlled substances pursuant to the terms of the Order.
