On December 10, 2020, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's practical nurse license. Respondent was required to complete one (1) hour of education in Critical Thinking: Nurse Calculations, two (2) hours of education on Critical Thinking: Nursing Calculations Part 2, and two (2) hours of education on Medication Safety: Protection Patients from Avoidable Harm pursuant to the terms of the Order.

Respondent has submitted proof that she successfully completed the required education and as a result the following is entered:
