The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final disposition of this matter, subject to the approval of the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services (Department). The Department has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Department in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent Darrell K. Harris (Birth Year 1989) is permitted by the State of Wisconsin as a private security person, having permit number 48976-108, first issued on January 15, 2014 and current through August 31, 2022. Respondent's most recent address on file with the Department is in Milwaukee, Wisconsin 53220.

2. On February 27, 2020, Respondent reported to the Department that he was convicted of an ordinance violation for battery. The Division of Legal Services and Compliance (DLSC) subsequently opened Case Number 20 RSG 004 for investigation.

3. On August 20, 2017, Respondent was involved in a physical confrontation at a bar in Milwaukee, Wisconsin. Respondent struck an individual in the face, causing significant injuries to the victim.

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4. On November 1, 2017, Respondent was convicted of Battery, an ordinance violation, in West Allis Municipal Court, Citation No. 1S80JFSSNQ.

5. On February 27, 2020, Respondent reported his ordinance violation to the Department.

6. In resolution of this matter, Respondent consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

#### CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 440.26(6), and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).

2. By the conduct described in the Findings of Fact, Respondent violated Wis. Stat. § 440.26(4m)(b) by failing to notify the Department of his ~~conviction~~ *violation* within 48 hours.

3. By the conduct described in the Findings of Fact, Respondent engaged in conduct reflecting adversely on his professional qualifications pursuant to Wis. Admin. Code § SPS 35.01(2) by violating a law the circumstances of which substantially relate to the practice of a private security person and failing to report his ~~conviction~~ *violation* to the Department within 48 hours.

4. As a result of the above violations, Respondent is subject to discipline pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 440.26(6)(a)1., 2., 3., and 4. and Wis. Admin. Code § SPS 35.01.

#### ORDER

1. The attached Stipulation is accepted.

2. Respondent Darrell K. Harris is REPRIMANDED.

3. Within ninety (90) days from the date of this Order, Respondent Darrell K. Harris shall pay the COSTS of this matter in the amount of \$338.00.

4. Payment of costs (made payable to the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services) shall be sent by Respondent to the Department Monitor at the address below:

In the event Respondent violates any term of this Order, Respondent's permit (number 48976-108), or Respondent's right to renew his permit, may, in the discretion of the Department or its designee, be SUSPENDED, without further notice or hearing, until Respondent has complied with the terms of the Order. The Department may, in addition and/or in the alternative, refer any violation of this Order to the Division of Legal Services and Compliance for further investigation and action.

6. This Order is effective on the date of its signing.

STIPULATION

ORDER 0007140

Division of Legal Services and Compliance Case No. 20 RSG 004

Respondent Darrell K. Harris and the Division of Legal Services and Compliance, Department of Safety and Professional Services stipulate as follows:

1. This Stipulation is entered into as a result of a pending investigation by the Division of Legal Services and Compliance. Respondent consents to the resolution of this investigation by Stipulation.

2. Respondent understands that by signing this Stipulation, Respondent voluntarily and knowingly waives the following rights:

- the right to a hearing on the allegations against Respondent, at which time the State has the burden of proving those allegations by a preponderance of the evidence;
- the right to confront and cross-examine the witnesses against Respondent;
- the right to call witnesses on Respondent's behalf and to compel their attendance by subpoena;
- the right to testify on Respondent's own behalf;
- the right to file objections to any proposed decision and to present briefs or oral arguments to the officials who are to render the final decision;
- the right to petition for rehearing; and
- all other applicable rights afforded to Respondent under the United States Constitution, the Wisconsin Constitution, the Wisconsin Statutes, the Wisconsin Administrative Code, and other provisions of state or federal law.

3. Respondent is aware of Respondent's right to seek legal representation and has been provided an opportunity to obtain legal counsel before signing this Stipulation.

4. Respondent agrees to the adoption of the attached Final Decision and Order by the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services (Department). The parties to the Stipulation consent to the entry of the attached Final Decision and Order without further notice, pleading, appearance or consent of the parties. Respondent waives all rights to any appeal of the Department's order, if adopted in the form as attached.


5. If the terms of this Stipulation are not acceptable to the Department, the parties shall not be bound by the contents of this Stipulation, and the matter shall then be returned to the Division of Legal Services and Compliance for further proceedings. In the event that the

Stipulation is not accepted by the Department, the parties agree not to contend that the Department has been prejudiced or biased in any manner by the consideration of this attempted resolution.


6. The parties to this Stipulation agree that the attorney or other agent for the Division of Legal Services and Compliance and any member of the Department ever assigned as an advisor in this investigation may appear before the Department in open or closed session, without the presence of Respondent, for purposes of speaking in support of this agreement and answering questions that any member of the Department may have in connection with deliberations on the Stipulation. Additionally, any such advisor may vote on whether the Department should accept this Stipulation and issue the attached Final Decision and Order.

7. Respondent is informed that should the Department adopt this Stipulation, the Department's Final Decision and Order is a public record and will be published in accordance with standard Department procedure.

8. The Division of Legal Services and Compliance joins Respondent in recommending the Department adopt this Stipulation and issue the attached Final Decision and Order.
