The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final disposition of this matter, subject to the approval of the Wisconsin Professional Engineer Section of the Wisconsin Examining Board of Architects, Landscape Architects, Professional Engineers, Designers and Professional Land Surveyors (Section). The Section has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Section in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Todd Reyling (Applicant) filed an application for a professional engineer certificate of registration (application ID #722476).
2. Applicant's most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services is located in Smithton, Illinois 62285.
3. Information received in the application process reflects that Applicant has received prior discipline in the following states:
 - a. Kansas, via a Settlement Agreement & Consent Order dated April 30, 2018.

- b. Illinois, via a Consent Order dated August 13, 2018.
- c. Missouri, via a Settlement Agreement & Joint Agreement Disciplinary Order dated July 18, 2019.
- d. Minnesota, via a Stipulation and Order dated September 9, 2019.
- e. Kentucky, via a Consent Decree dated April 26, 2019.
- f. Ohio, via a Settlement Agreement dated November 27, 2018.
- g. North Carolina, Applicant disclosed reciprocal discipline based on the above.
- h. Georgia, Applicant disclosed reciprocal discipline based on the above.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Section has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 443.11 and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).
- 2. By the conduct stated in the above Findings of Fact, Applicant violated Wis. Admin. Code § A-E 8.09(1) by failing to comply with all state codes which relate to the practice of professional engineering.
- 3. By the conduct stated in the above Findings of Fact, Applicant engaged in misconduct pursuant to Wis. Admin. Code § A-E 8.03(3)(a) by violating federal or state laws, local ordinances or administrative rules relating to the practice of professional engineering.

ORDER

- 1. The attached Stipulation is accepted.
- 2. Applicant's application for a professional engineer certificate of registration is granted subject to the following limitations.
- 3. The professional engineer certificate of registration issued to Applicant to practice professional engineering in the State of Wisconsin, is LIMITED as follows:
 - a. Applicant shall comply with, and successfully complete, the terms of the Settlement Agreement Between Missouri Board for Architects, Professional Engineers, Professional Land Surveyors, and Professional Landscape Architects and Todd Jeffrey Reyling, dated July 18, 2019.
 - b. Applicant shall submit to the Section copies of all quarterly reports submitted to the Missouri Board for Architects, Professional Engineers, Professional Land Surveyors, and Professional Landscape Architects on the same date that the reports are provided to the Missouri Board.

4. The Section or its designee may, without hearing, suspend Applicant's professional engineer certificate of registration upon receipt of information that Applicant is in violation of any provision of this Order. The Section or its designee may, in conjunction with suspension, prohibit Applicant from seeking termination of the suspension for a specified period of time.

5. The Section or its designee may terminate the suspension if provided with sufficient information that Applicant is in compliance with the Order and that it is appropriate for suspension to be terminated. Whether to terminate the suspension shall be wholly in the discretion of the Section or its designee.

6. The Section may refer any violation of this Order to the Division of Legal Services and Compliance for investigation and action.

7. After Applicant has successfully complied with the terms of this Order, Applicant may petition the Board for the removal of limitations from Applicant's certificate of registration. The Board may grant or deny any petition, in its discretion, or may modify this Order as it sees fit.


It is stipulated between the Applicant and the Wisconsin Professional Engineer Section of the Wisconsin Examining Board of Architects, Landscape Architects, Professional Engineers, as follows:

1. The Applicant has filed an application for a professional engineer certificate of registration.
2. Information received by the Section reflects a basis to grant the application for a certificate of registration subject to limitations.
3. Based upon the information of record herein, the Section agrees to issue, and the Applicant agrees to accept, an Order granting a certificate of registration as a professional engineer, subject to the terms and conditions set forth in the attached Order adopting the Stipulation.
4. Applicant understands that by signing this Stipulation, Applicant voluntarily and knowingly waives the following rights:
 - the right to request a hearing related to the denial of the unlimited application;
 - the right to confront and cross-examine the witnesses against Applicant;
 - the right to call witnesses on Applicant's behalf and to compel their attendance by subpoena;
 - the right to testify on Applicant's own behalf;
 - the right to file objections to any proposed decision and to present briefs or oral arguments to the officials who are to render the final decision;
 - the right to petition for rehearing; and
 - all other applicable rights afforded to the Applicant under the United States Constitution, the Wisconsin Constitution, the Wisconsin Statutes, the Wisconsin Administrative Code, and other provisions of state or federal law.
5. Applicant is aware of Applicant's right to seek legal representation and has been provided an opportunity to obtain legal counsel before signing this Stipulation.

6. Applicant agrees to the adoption of the attached Order Granting Limited Certificate the Section. The parties to the Stipulation consent to the entry of the attached Order Granting Limited Certificate without further notice, appearance, or consent of the parties.

7. Applicant waives all rights to any appeal of the Section's Order, as adopted in the form attached.

8. Applicant is informed that the Order Granting Limited Certificate is a public record will be published in accordance with standard procedure.
