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MICHELLE LEFEBVRE (Applicant), voluntarily and knowingly agrees to the issuance of a LIMITED license for the SOLE PURPOSE of completing a Wisconsin Board of Nursing (Board) approved nurse refresher course (Refresher Course), pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 441.06(1m) and Wis. Admin. Code § N 2.40(3)(d).

Upon successful completion of the Refresher Course, Applicant may petition the Board to complete the review of Applicant's application by submitting a request for review including:

- documentation demonstrating Applicant's successful completion of the Refresher Course, and
- the completed fitness to practice evaluation, completed by the Board-approved evaluator.

The Board will complete review of Applicant's application for reinstatement at that time.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that Applicant's LIMITED license for the SOLE PURPOSE of completion of a Refresher Course IS GRANTED.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that pursuant to the Enhanced Nurse Licensure Compact, this LIMITED license for the SOLE PURPOSE of enabling the Applicant to complete the Refresher Course is limited to Wisconsin during the duration of this limitation.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the LIMITED license shall be valid for a period of one (1) year from the date of this Order. If the refresher course is not completed within one (1) year, the LIMITED license will expire, and the Applicant will need to reapply for a limited license to complete the course.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that upon successful completion of the Refresher Course the Applicant may petition the Board to complete the legal review of Applicant's criminal

background check, impairment, prior license discipline, multistate privilege eligibility, and any other outstanding matters.
