On February 9, 2021, the Wisconsin Real Estate Examining Board issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") requiring Respondent to complete the fifteen (15) hour National USPAP course within sixty (60) days. On September 29, 2021, Respondent's certified residential appraiser certificate of licensure was suspended for failure to complete the education as ordered.

Based upon the information of record, which includes proof that Respondent has now completed the education, the following is entered:
