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
An investigation by the Department found a seismograph report for a blast performed on May 11, 2020, at the CCI Limestone Quarry, 3800 Gateway Blvd. Beloit, WI 53511 exceeded the limits set forth in the table found at Wis. Admin. Code § SPS 307.44. Upon information and

belief, this blast was not reported to the Department as required by Wis. Admin. Code § SPS 307.44(5).

According to Wis. Admin. Code § SPS 307.10 the penalties for violating any provision in Chapter 307 relating to explosives shall be assessed in accordance with Wis. Stat. § 101.02 (12) and (13). A forfeiture of no less than \$10 nor more than \$100 is to be assessed for each violation.

For these reasons a forfeiture of \$50.00 is assessed in accordance with Wis. Stat. § 101.02(13).
