The parties agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final disposition of these matters, subject to the approval of the Wisconsin Board of Nursing (Board). The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in these matters adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent Shenandoah Greenwood, R.N., (DOB xx-xx-1981), is licensed in the state of Wisconsin as a registered nurse with multistate privileges pursuant to the Enhanced Nurse Licensure Compact (Compact), having license number 161820-30, first issued on March 5, 2008, and current through February 28, 2022. Respondent's most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services (Department) is in Green Bay, Wisconsin 54311-7329.

2. At all times relevant to these proceedings, Respondent practiced as a traveling or agency nurse at various health facilities in Wisconsin.

3. The Department's Division of Legal Services and Compliance (DLSC) opened case numbers 17 NUR 578, 18 NUR 400, 18 NUR 612, 20 NUR 140 to investigate allegations from Respondent's employers of various violations of professional conduct, including impairment at work, failure to follow a not-by-mouth order, medication administration discrepancies and charting errors, and diversion.

4. Respondent denies the allegations but does not wish to incur the time and expense involved in contested disciplinary proceedings. Therefore, Respondent agrees to resolve DLSC case numbers 17 NUR 578, 18 NUR 400, 18 NUR 612, 20 NUR 140 by consenting to the entry of the following Conclusion of Law and Order.

CONCLUSION OF LAW

1. The Board has jurisdiction to act in these matters pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 441.07, and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).

ORDER

1. The attached Stipulation is accepted.

2. The voluntary SURRENDER of the license to practice as a registered nurse in the state of Wisconsin issued to Respondent Shenandoah Greenwood (License No. 161820-30), and the privilege to practice as a registered nurse under the authority of the Compact, is accepted.

3. Respondent shall not petition the Board for reinstatement of her license to practice as a registered nurse in the state of Wisconsin for at least two (2) years from the date of this Order.

4. In the event Respondent petitions the Board for reinstatement, the Board may enter an order denying such petition without further notice or hearing. Whether to grant a license and whether to impose any limitations or restrictions on any license shall be in the sole discretion of the Board.

5. In the event Respondent petitions the Board for reinstatement of her license to practice as a registered nurse in the state of Wisconsin or applies for another credential with this Department, Respondent shall pay the costs of these matters in the amount of \$2,275.00 before any petition or application will be considered.


6. Respondent shall immediately return all indicia of licensure to the Department Monitor at the address below:

STIPULATION

ORDER 0007296

Division of Legal Services and Compliance Case Nos.

Respondent Shenandoah Greenwood, R.N., and the Division of Legal Services and Compliance, Department of Safety and Professional Services, stipulate as follows:

1. This Stipulation is entered into as a result of four (4) pending investigations by the Division of Legal Services and Compliance. Respondent consents to the resolution of these investigations by Stipulation.

2. Respondent understands that by signing this Stipulation, Respondent voluntarily and knowingly waives the following rights:

- the right to a hearing on the allegations against Respondent, at which time the State has the burden of proving those allegations by a preponderance of the evidence;
- the right to confront and cross-examine the witnesses against Respondent;
- the right to call witnesses on Respondent's behalf and to compel their attendance by subpoena;
- the right to testify on Respondent's own behalf;
- the right to file objections to any proposed decision and to present briefs or oral arguments to the officials who are to render the final decision;
- the right to petition for rehearing; and
- all other applicable rights afforded to Respondent under the United States Constitution, the Wisconsin Constitution, the Wisconsin Statutes, the Wisconsin Administrative Code, and other provisions of state or federal law.

3. Respondent is aware of Respondent's right to seek legal representation and has been provided an opportunity to obtain legal counsel before signing this Stipulation. Respondent is represented by Attorney Maria Kysely Schneider.


4. Respondent agrees to the adoption of the attached Final Decision and Order by the Wisconsin Board of Nursing (Board). The parties to the Stipulation consent to the entry of the attached Final Decision and Order without further notice, pleading, appearance or consent of the parties. Respondent waives all rights to any appeal of the Board's order, if adopted in the form as attached.

5. If the terms of this Stipulation are not acceptable to the Board, the parties shall not be bound by the contents of this Stipulation, and the matters shall then be returned to the Division of Legal Services and Compliance for further proceedings. In the event that the Stipulation is not accepted by the Board, the parties agree not to contend that the Board has been prejudiced or biased in any manner by the consideration of this attempted resolution.

6. The parties to this Stipulation agree that the attorney or other agent for the Division of Legal Services and Compliance and any member of the Board ever assigned as an advisor in these investigations may appear before the Board in open or closed session, without the presence of Respondent or Respondent's attorney, for purposes of speaking in support of this agreement and answering questions that any member of the Board may have in connection with deliberations on the Stipulation. Additionally, any such advisor may vote on whether the Board should accept this Stipulation and issue the attached Final Decision and Order.


7. Respondent is informed that should the Board adopt this Stipulation, the Board's Final Decision and Order is a public record and will be published in accordance with standard Department procedure.
