
On April 15, 2021, the Wisconsin Real Estate Examining Board (“Board”) issued a Final Decision and Order (“Order”) limiting Respondent’s real estate salesperson license. Respondent was required to complete two (2) remedial education courses on the topic of business ethics (3 credits) and approved forms (3 credits) pursuant to the terms of the Order.

Respondent has submitted proof that he successfully completed the required education and as a result the following is entered:

1. Respondent’s real estate salesperson license (#64230-94) is returned to full, unrestricted status.
2. All limitations and encumbrances upon Respondent’s credential are removed.
