The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final disposition of this matter, subject to the approval of the Social Worker Section of the Wisconsin Marriage and Family Therapy, Professional Counseling, and Social Work Examining Board (Section). The Section has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Section in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Order.

#### **FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. Crystal L. Ognan, S.W., S.A.C., (Respondent), (Year of Birth 1990) is certified in the state of Wisconsin to practice social work, having certificate number 12805-120, first issued on June 28, 2018, and current through February 28, 2023. Respondent is also certified as a substance abuse counselor, having certificate number 16388-131, first issued on April 24, 2020, and current through February 28, 2023. Respondent also held a substance abuse counselor-intraining certificate, number 18533-130, issued on March 30, 2018, and expired on February 28,

- 2021. Respondent's most recent address on file with the Department is in Chilton, Wisconsin 53014.
- 2. At all times relevant to this proceeding, Respondent was employed as a social worker at a drug abuse correctional facility (Facility), located in Winnebago, Wisconsin.
- 3. In 2019 and 2020, Respondent provided treatment and counseling services to Inmate A who was housed at the Facility. Inmate A was released from the Facility on March 23, 2020.
- 4. Three weeks after Inmate A's release from the Facility, Respondent and Inmate A began a consensual sexual relationship which continued for several weeks. Respondent asserted that she ended the relationship with Inmate A in May 2020 because Inmate A had become aggressive and threatening.
- 5. Respondent was terminated from the Facility on July 14, 2020, as a result of her relationship with Inmate A.
- 6. In resolution of this matter, Respondent consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

#### **CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

- 1. The Section has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 457.26 and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).
- 2. By the conduct described in the Findings of Fact, Respondent engaged in unprofessional conduct as defined by Wis. Admin. Code § MPSW 20.02(11), by engaging in sexual contact, sexual conduct, or any other behavior with a client which could reasonably be construed as seductive. For purposes of this rule, a person shall continue to be a client for 2 years after the termination of professional services.
- 3. As a result of the above violations, Respondent is subject to discipline pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 457.26(2)(f) and (h).

#### ORDER

- 1. The attached Stipulation is accepted.
- 2. The certificate issued to Respondent (certificate number 12805-120) to practice social work in the state of Wisconsin, and Respondent's appurtenant right to renew such certificate, is SUSPENDED for one (1) year retroactively from the effective date of the Department's Order in Division and Legal Services and Compliance (DLSC) case number 20

RSA 024 regarding her substance abuse counselor certificate and substance abuse counselor-in-training certificate.

- 3. The certificate issued to Respondent (certificate number 12805-120) to practice social work in the state of Wisconsin, and Respondent's appurtenant right to renew such certificate, is LIMITED as follows:
  - a. Respondent shall fully and satisfactorily comply with the terms of the Final Decision and Order issued in 20 RSA 024. The question of whether Respondent fully and satisfactorily complies with the terms of any Order issued in 20 RSA 024 is solely within the discretion of the Department and/or its designee.
  - b. If the Evaluator who conducts the fitness for practice evaluation in Department Order for DLSC case number 20 RSA 024 determines that Respondent is not fit for practice or is fit for practice with limitations, the Section or its designee may suspend Respondent's social worker certificate until Respondent provides proof sufficient to convince the Section or its designee that Respondent is able to practice with reasonable skill and safety of patients and the public and does not suffer from any condition which prevents Respondent from practicing in that manner.
  - c. If the Evaluator determines that Respondent is fit for practice or is fit for practice with limitations, the Section or its designee may limit Respondent's social worker certificate in a manner to address any concerns the Section or its designee has as a result of the conduct set out in the Findings of Fact and to address any recommendations resulting from the evaluation, including, but not limited to:
    - 1. Psychotherapy, at Respondent's expense, by a therapist approved by the Section or its designee, to address specific treatment goals, with quarterly reports to the Section or its designee by the therapist.
    - 2. Additional professional education in any identified areas of deficiency.
    - 3. Restrictions on the nature of practice, practice setting, or requirements for supervision of practice by a professional approved by the Section or its designee, with periodic reports to the Section or its designee by the supervisor.
- 4. Within 120 days from the date of this Order, Respondent shall pay COSTS of this matter in the amount of \$357.00.
- 5. Petitions, proof of satisfactory completion of the terms of any Order issued in 20 RSA 024, payment of costs (made payable to the Wisconsin Department of Safety and

Professional Services), and any other request related to this Order shall be sent by Respondent to the Department Monitor at the address below:

- 6. In the event that Respondent violates any term of this Order, Respondent's certificate (no. 12805-120) to practice social work in the state of Wisconsin, and Respondent's appurtenant right to renew such certificate may, in the discretion of the Section or its designee, be SUSPENDED, without further notice or hearing, until Respondent has complied with the terms of the Order. The Section may, in addition and/or in the alternative refer any violation of this Order to the Division of Legal Services and Compliance for further investigation and action.
  - 7. This Order is effective on the date of its signing.

Crystal L. Ognan, S.W., S.A.C. (Respondent) and the Division of Legal Services and Compliance, Department of Safety and Professional Services stipulate as follows:

- 1. This Stipulation is entered into as a result of a pending investigation by the Division of Legal Services and Compliance. Respondent consents to the resolution of this investigation by Stipulation.
- 2. Respondent understands that by signing this Stipulation, Respondent voluntarily and knowingly waives the following rights:
  - the right to a hearing on the allegations against Respondent, at which time the State has the burden of proving those allegations by a preponderance of the evidence;
  - the right to confront and cross-examine the witnesses against Respondent;
  - the right to call witnesses on Respondent's behalf and to compel their attendance by subpoena;
  - the right to testify on Respondent's own behalf;
  - the right to file objections to any proposed decision and to present briefs or oral arguments to the officials who are to render the final decision;
  - the right to petition for rehearing; and
  - all other applicable rights afforded to Respondent under the United States Constitution, the Wisconsin Constitution, the Wisconsin Statutes, the Wisconsin Administrative Code, and other provisions of state or federal law.
- 3. Respondent is aware of Respondent's right to seek legal representation and has been provided an opportunity to obtain legal counsel before signing this Stipulation.
- 4. Respondent agrees to the adoption of the attached Final Decision and Order by the Wisconsin Social Worker Section of the Marriage and Family Therapy, Professional Counseling and Social Work Examining Board (Section). The parties to the Stipulation consent to the entry of the attached Final Decision and Order without further notice, pleading, appearance or consent of the parties. Respondent waives all rights to any appeal of the Board's order, if adopted in the form as attached.

- 5. If the terms of this Stipulation are not acceptable to the Section the parties shall not be bound by the contents of this Stipulation, and the matter shall then be returned to the Division of Legal Services and Compliance for further proceedings. In the event that the Stipulation is not accepted by the Section, the parties agree not to contend that the Section has been prejudiced or biased in any manner by the consideration of this attempted resolution.
- 6. The parties to this Stipulation agree that the attorney or other agent for the Division of Legal Services and Compliance and any member of the Section ever assigned as an advisor in this investigation may appear before the Section in open or closed session, without the presence of Respondent, for purposes of speaking in support of this agreement and answering questions that any member of the Section may have in connection with deliberations on the Stipulation. Additionally, any such advisor may vote on whether the Section should accept this Stipulation and issue the attached Final Decision and Order.
- 7. Respondent is informed that should the Section adopt this Stipulation, the Section's Final Decision and Order is a public record and will be published in accordance with standard Department procedure.
- 8. The Division of Legal Services and Compliance joins Respondent in recommending the Section adopt this Stipulation and issue the attached Final Decision and Order.
