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

You are receiving this forfeiture because a Department investigation found you performed electrical work at 101 West Adams Street, Colby Wisconsin without possessing any electrical license. A license is required in the State of Wisconsin to perform most electrical work. The Department spoke to you at the site and you admitted to doing the electrical work and it was determined by the Department that the work you performed would require a license/credential. The Department then attempted to contact you numerous times for a formal response to the allegations. The Department located your home address using the Wisconsin Circuit Court Access (CCAP) system. The Department then sent a letter to both your home address and post

office box that were listed on the CCAP system. No response was received. The Department made reasonable efforts to afford you an opportunity to respond. Last, a search of Department credential records shows that you have not obtained any license as of this date.

For engaging in electrical work without the proper credential the forfeiture of \$250.00 is assessed in accordance with Wis. Stat. § 101.88(3).
