NOTICE OF FORFEITURE

Re: UNLICENSED ELECTRICAL, PLUMBING, AND HVAC WORK

You are hereby notified that you are subject to a forfeiture of **\$1,100.00** in accordance with Wis. Stat. § 101.88(3), Wis. Stat. § 101.178(5), and Wis. Admin. Code § SPS 305.125(1)(b) because you engaged in electrical, HVAC, and plumbing work without possessing the necessary credentials in violation of Wis. Stat. § 101.862(2), Wis. Stat. § 145.06(1)(a) and Wis. Stat. § 101.178(2). This forfeiture must be paid within 30 days of the date of mailing of this Notice, or a 12% interest penalty will be assessed and/or enforcement action may be taken against you. In addition, you shall not be able to obtain a credential from the Department of Safety and Professional Services until this forfeiture is paid.

The forfeiture of **\$1,100.00** shall be made out to the "Department of Safety and Professional Services." Include in the memo line "21 UNL 19" and send to the following address:


You are receiving this forfeiture because a Department investigation found you performed electrical, plumbing, and HVAC work at the Manawa Masonic Lodge, 520 N Bridge St, Manawa, WI 54949 without possessing the proper credentials. Credentials are required in the State of Wisconsin to perform most electrical, plumbing, and HVAC work. An inspection found code violations stemming from the work you performed. These code violations are safety concerns for the members of the lodge and any frequenters who visit the lodge.

The Department provided you an opportunity to respond and you admitted to doing electrical, plumbing, and HVAC work.

For engaging in electrical work without the proper credential the Department enters a forfeiture of \$50.00 in accordance with Wis. Stat. § 101.88(3). For engaging in plumbing work without the proper credential the Department enters a forfeiture of \$1,000 as required by Wis. Admin. Code § SPS 305.125(1)(b). For engaging in HVAC work without the proper credential the Department enters a forfeiture of \$50.00 in accordance with Wis. Stat. § 101.178(5).

You have the right to request a review of the assessment of forfeiture by sending a request addressed to Division Administrator, Division of Industry Services, P.O. Box 7302, Madison, WI 53707-7302. Any review of the assessment of forfeiture will be held in accordance with the requirements set forth in Wis. Admin. Code § SPS 305.125. Such request for review shall set out specifically and in full detail every reason why this order is unreasonable, and every issue to be considered by the Department in the review.
