You are hereby notified that you are subject to a forfeiture of \$250.00 in accordance with Wis. Stat. § 101.88(3) because you engaged in electrical work without possessing the necessary credential in violation of Wis. Stat. § 101.862(2). This forfeiture must be paid within 30 days of the date of mailing of this Notice, or a 12% interest penalty will be assessed and/or enforcement action may be taken against you. In addition, your credentials (DC-021800012, DCQ-21800018) shall remain suspended under Order ______ until this forfeiture is paid.

You are receiving this forfeiture because a Department investigation found you performed electrical work at 2119 Superior Avenue Oconto, WI 54153 without possessing any electrical license. A license is required in the state of Wisconsin to perform most electrical work. An investigation by the Department found a preponderance of evidence that you engaged in electrical work. The Department spoke with the inspector for the project who indicated that electrical work was performed. A review of your invoice to the homeowners indicate that a new vent fan was to be installed. Last, you admitted that you installed a new vent fan.

You have the right to request a hearing on this matter by sending a request for hearing to the Department of Safety and Professional Services, Chief Legal Counsel, P.O. Box 7190, Madison, Wisconsin 53707-7190, which must be received by the Department no later than 30 days from the date of mailing of this Notice. Any review will be held in accordance with the requirements set forth in Wis. Stat. § 101.02(6). Such request for review shall set out specifically and in full detail every reason why this order is unreasonable, and every issue to be considered by the Department in the review

For engaging in electrical work without the proper credential the forfeiture of \$250.00 is assessed in accordance with Wis. Stat. § 101.88(3).
