The parties agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final disposition of these matters, subject to the approval of the Medical Examining Board (Board). The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in these matters adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Respondent Paul W. Sperduto, M.D., (Year of Birth 1958) is licensed in the state of Wisconsin to practice medicine and surgery, having license number 55228-20, first issued on December 10, 2010, with registration current through October 31, 2021. Respondent's most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services (Department) is in Edina, Minnesota 55439.
- 2. At all times pertinent to this matter, Respondent practiced as a radiation oncologist at radiation therapy centers located in Waconia, Minnesota, and Minneapolis, Minnesota.

- 3. The Department's Division of Legal Services and Compliance (DLSC) opened case number 21 MED 308 to investigate an allegation of unprofessional conduct related to Respondent's practice in Minnesota.
- 4. Respondent plans to retire from the practice of medicine and surgery in the near future, and recently voluntarily surrendered his Minnesota license in light of that intention.
- 5. Respondent denies engaging in unprofessional conduct. However, Respondent does not wish to incur expenses in a contested disciplinary proceeding, and therefore agrees to surrender his Wisconsin license and the right to renew that license to resolve this matter.
 - 6. Respondent consents to the entry of the following Conclusion of Law and Order.

CONCLUSION OF LAW

1. The Board has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 448.02(3), and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).

ORDER

- 1. The attached Stipulation is accepted.
- 2. The VOLUNTARY SURRENDER by Respondent of his license and registration to practice medicine and surgery in the state of Wisconsin (license number 55228-20), and his right to renew that license and registration, is accepted.
- 3. In the event Respondent petitions the Board for reinstatement of his license to practice medicine and surgery in the state of Wisconsin, the Board may enter an order denying such petition without further notice or hearing. Whether to grant a license and whether to impose any limitations or restrictions on any license shall be in the sole discretion of the Board.
- 4. In the event Respondent petitions the Board or Department for reinstatement of his license to practice medicine and surgery or applies for any other credential under Wis. Stat. chs. 440-480, Respondent shall pay costs in this matter in the amount of \$375.00 as a prerequisite to any such petition for reinstatement or application for credential.
 - 5. This Order is effective as of the date of its signing.

STIPULATION ORDER 0007754

Division of Legal Services and Compliance Case No. 21 MED 308

Respondent Paul W. Sperduto, M.D., and the Division of Legal Services and Compliance, Department of Safety and Professional Services, stipulate as follows:

- 1. This Stipulation is entered into as a result of a pending investigation by the Division of Legal Services and Compliance. Respondent consents to the resolution of this investigation by Stipulation.
- 2. Respondent understands that by signing this Stipulation, Respondent voluntarily and knowingly waives the following rights:
 - the right to a hearing on the allegations against Respondent, at which time the State has the burden of proving those allegations by a preponderance of the evidence;
 - the right to confront and cross-examine the witnesses against Respondent;
 - the right to call witnesses on Respondent's behalf and to compel their attendance by subpoena;
 - the right to testify on Respondent's own behalf;
 - the right to file objections to any proposed decision and to present briefs or oral arguments to the officials who are to render the final decision;
 - the right to petition for rehearing; and
 - all other applicable rights afforded to Respondent under the United States Constitution, the Wisconsin Constitution, the Wisconsin Statutes, the Wisconsin Administrative Code, and other provisions of state or federal law.
- 3. Respondent is aware of Respondent's right to seek legal representation and has been provided an opportunity to obtain legal counsel before signing this Stipulation. Respondent is represented by Attorney Guy DuBeau.
- 4. Respondent agrees to the adoption of the attached Final Decision and Order by the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board (Board). The parties to the Stipulation consent to the entry of the attached Final Decision and Order without further notice, pleading, appearance or consent of the parties. Respondent waives all rights to any appeal of the Board's order, if adopted in the form as attached.

- 5. If the terms of this Stipulation are not acceptable to the Board, the parties shall not be bound by the contents of this Stipulation, and the matter shall then be returned to the Division of Legal Services and Compliance for further proceedings. In the event that the Stipulation is not accepted by the Board, the parties agree not to contend that the Board has been prejudiced or biased in any manner by the consideration of this attempted resolution.
- 6. The parties to this Stipulation agree that the attorney or other agent for the Division of Legal Services and Compliance and any member of the Board ever assigned as an advisor in this investigation may appear before the Board in open or closed session, without the presence of Respondent, for purposes of speaking in support of this agreement and answering questions that any member of the Board may have in connection with deliberations on the Stipulation. Additionally, any such advisor may vote on whether the Board should accept this Stipulation and issue the attached Final Decision and Order.
- 7. Respondent is informed that should the Board adopt this Stipulation, the Board's Final Decision and Order is a public record and will be published in accordance with standard Department procedure.
- 8. The Division of Legal Services and Compliance joins Respondent in recommending the Board adopt this Stipulation and issue the attached Final Decision and Order.
