On February 13, 2014, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing (“Board”) issued a Final Decision and Order (“Order”) suspending Respondent’s professional nursing license for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On September 8, 2022, the Board considered Respondent’s request for access to controlled substances, decrease in AODA treatment from twice per month to once per quarter, and/or a reduction in drug test frequency. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent’s request for a reduction in drug test frequency is hereby GRANTED. Respondent’s frequency is reduced to not less than thirty-six (36) screens per year.
2. Respondent’s request for access to controlled substances, and a decrease in AODA treatment from twice per month to once per quarter are hereby DENIED.
3. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
4. This order is effective the date of its signing.
