On October 23, 2018, the Social Worker Section of the Wisconsin Marriage and Family Therapy, Professional Counseling, and Social Work Examining Board (Section) issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") stipulating the voluntary surrender of the certificate to practice social work in the state of Wisconsin by the Respondent. Respondent applied for reinstatement of their certificate. Upon review of the information of record, the following is entered:

ORDER

1. Respondent is hereby REQUIRED to meet the following conditions in order to be eligible to apply for a social work credential in the State of Wisconsin:

- a. Respondent shall, at her own expense, successfully complete four (4) hours of education on the subject of boundaries and two (2) hours education on the subject of dual relationships, offered by a provider(s) pre-approved by the Section's monitoring liaison, including taking and passing any exam offered for the courses.
- b. Respondent shall submit proof of successful completion for the education in the form of verification from the institution providing the education to the Department Monitor at the address stated below. None of the education completed pursuant to this requirement may be used to satisfy any continuing education requirements that have been or may be instituted by the Section or Department, and also may not be used in future attempts to upgrade a credential in Wisconsin.
- c. The Section's monitoring liaison may change the number of credit hours and/or education topics in response to a request from Respondent. The monitoring liaison may consider the topic availability and/or hours of education when determining if a change to the ordered education should occur.

2. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
