On December 12, 2019, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's professional nursing license (#227225-30) for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and her license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On March 10, 2022, the Board considered Respondent's request for a reduction in AA/NA meetings and a reduction in the frequency of drug and alcohol screens. Based upon the information of record, the following is entered:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for a reduction in AA/NA meetings and a reduction in the frequency of drug and alcohol screens is GRANTED. Respondent is now required to attend AA/NA meetings once per week and test at a frequency of not less than thirty-six (36) times per year.

2. This order is effective the date of its signing.
