On January 30, 2020, the Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's license to practice pharmacy for an indefinite period. Respondent is required to, at his own expense, "complete a Fitness to Practice evaluation with a pre-approved psychiatrist or psychologist (Evaluator) who has not provided treatment to Respondent and is experienced in evaluating whether a health care professional is fit to practice."

On September 1, 2022, the Board considered Respondent's request to have Joseph T. Bergs, M.D., be his approved evaluator for a new fitness to practice evaluation. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:
