On May 14, 2020, the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board (“Board”) issued an Order Granting Limited License (“Order”) granting Applicant a license to practice medicine and surgery with certain terms and conditions.

On June 15, 2022, the Board considered Applicant’s request for reduction in daily check-ins with drug monitoring program from daily to bi-weekly, increase from five hours to fourteen days to produce a specimen for drug testing, reduction in drug test frequency to no more than twelve times per year, and termination of professional mentor requirements. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Applicant’s request for termination of professional mentor requirements is hereby GRANTED.
2. Applicant’s request for a reduction in drug and alcohol screens is hereby GRANTED. Applicant’s frequency is reduced to not less than thirty-six (36) urine screens per year and one annual hair test.
3. Applicant’s request for reduction in daily check-ins with drug monitoring program from daily to bi-weekly is hereby DENIED.
4. Applicant’s request for increase from five hours to fourteen days to produce a specimen for drug testing is hereby DENIED.
5. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
6. This order is effective the date of its signing.
