On May 14, 2020, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's professional nursing license with certain terms and conditions, including participation in a drug monitoring program.

On September 8, 2022, the Board considered Respondent's request for a reduction in drug test frequency and/or a reduction of AA/NA meetings from twice per week to once per week. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for a reduction in drug screens is hereby GRANTED. Respondent's frequency is reduced to not less than twenty-eight (28) per year and one (1) annual hair test.
2. Respondent's request for a decrease in frequency of AA/NA meetings to once per week is hereby GRANTED.
3. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
4. This order is effective the date of its signing.
