On January 28, 2021, the Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's license to practice pharmacy for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and his license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On November 3, 2022, the Board considered Respondent's request for the addition of four (4) hours per month as a pharmacist in charge and/or the reduction in drug and alcohol screens. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for the addition of four (4) hours per month as pharmacist in charge is hereby GRANTED.
2. Respondent's request for the reduction in drug and alcohol screens is hereby DENIED.
3. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
4. This order is effective the date of its signing.
