
On July 28, 2021, the Wisconsin Real Estate Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent Moutry's real estate broker license. Respondent Moutry was required to complete one course of education on the topic of transaction documents pursuant to the terms of the Order.

Respondent Moutry has submitted proof that she successfully completed the required education and as a result the following is entered:

1. Respondent Moutry's real estate broker license (no. 56720-90) is returned to full, unrestricted status.
