On August 12, 2021, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's professional nursing license with certain terms and conditions including, but not limited to, completion of an assessment by an approved mental health provider experienced in evaluating health care practitioners' fitness for duty. The Order further states that Respondent's license shall be limited in a manner to address any concerns the Board has with the conduct set out in the Order's findings of fact and to address any recommendations resulting from the assessment.

On August 11, 2022, the Board reviewed and accepted the report resulting from Respondent's fitness for duty assessment. Based on the assessor's recommendations, the following is entered:

ORDER

- 1. Respondent's professional nursing license (#199453-30) is further LIMITED as follows:
 - a. For a period of one (1) year from the date of this Order, Respondent shall provide a copy of this Order, and any subsequent order modifying this original Order, immediately to supervisory personnel at all settings where Respondent works as a nurse or care giver or provides health care, currently or in the future. Within fourteen (14) days from the date of this Order, including any subsequent order modifying this original Order, Respondent shall provide the Department Monitor with written acknowledgment from the employer that a copy of this Order, and any subsequent order modifying this original Order, have been received and that the restrictions will be accommodated.

- b. For a period of one (1) year from the date of this Order, it is Respondent's responsibility to arrange for quarterly written reports to be submitted to the Department Monitor from his or her supervisor at each setting in which Respondent practiced nursing in the previous quarter. These reports shall be submitted as directed by the Department Monitor, and shall assess Respondent's work performance, and shall include the number of hours of active nursing practice worked during that quarter. If a report indicates less than satisfactory performance, the Board may institute appropriate corrective limitations, or may revoke a stay of the suspension, in its discretion.
