On September 9, 2021, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order"), which limited Respondent's professional nursing license with certain terms and conditions.

On October 13, 2022, the Board considered Respondent's request for a reduction in the frequency of drug/alcohol screens and to have access to controlled substances in a work setting. Based upon the information of record, the following is entered:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for a reduction in drug test frequency is hereby GRANTED. Respondent's frequency of drug and alcohol screens is reduced to not less than thirty-six (36) times per year.
2. Respondent's request to be allowed access to controlled substances in a work setting is hereby GRANTED.
3. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
4. This order is effective the date of its signing.
