On September 9, 2021, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's professional nursing license and Advanced Practice Nurse Prescriber license with certain terms and conditions including, but not limited to, completion of an assessment by an approved mental health provider experienced in evaluating health care practitioners' fitness for duty. The Order further states that Respondent's license shall be limited in a manner to address any concerns the Board has with the conduct set out in the Order's findings of fact and to address any recommendations resulting from the assessment.

On January 13, 2022, the Board reviewed and accepted the report resulting from Respondent's fitness for duty assessment. Based on the assessor's recommendations, the following is entered:

<u>ORDER</u>

1. Respondent's professional nursing license (#136361-30) and Advanced Practice Nurse Prescriber license (#4359-33) is further LIMITED as follows for at least six (6) months from the date of the Order:

- A. Work Restrictions:
 - i. Part-time work up to 20 hours per week with shifts of 8 hours or less
 - ii. Accommodations of an in-person scribe
 - iii. Weekly monitoring of record completion by a supervisor or manager
 - iv. Submission of quarterly work reports
- B. Treatment as described by evaluator
 - i. Continuing psychiatric monitoring and medications for ADHD symptoms
 - ii. Continuing medical monitoring for medical conditions contributing to fatigue
 - iii. Documentation from treater(s) attesting to 1.B.i. & 1.B.ii.
