On November 3, 2021, the Wisconsin Dentistry Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's license to practice dentistry in the state of Wisconsin. Respondent was required to complete a total of eight (8) hours of continuing education on the topic of managing oral infections and endodontic emergencies pursuant to the terms of the Order.
