On December 6, 2021, the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services ("Department") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's Acupuncturist license. Respondent was required to complete four (4) of education on patient documentation and effective recordkeeping, four (4) hours on electronic medical records and four (4) hours on safety considerations in patient care. The education completed pursuant to the Order may not be used to satisfy any other registered Acupuncturist continuing education requirements with the Department. Respondent was also required to pay \$806.00 in costs.

Respondent has submitted proof that he successfully completed the education and paid costs in full, as a result, the following is entered:

ORDER

1. Respondent's Acupuncturist license (#131-55) is returned to full, unrestricted status.
2. All limitations and encumbrances upon Respondent's credential are removed.
3. This order is effective the date of its signing.
