The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final disposition of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board of Nursing (Board). The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Melissa M. Collins, R.N. (Respondent), (Year of Birth 1972) is licensed in the state of Wisconsin as a registered nurse, having license number 144341-30, first issued on October 16, 2003. This license expired on February 29, 2020 and has not been renewed. Pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 440.08(3), Respondent retains the right to renew upon payment of a fee until February 28, 2025. Respondent's most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services (Department) is in Fort Mill, South Carolina 29708.

PRIOR DISCIPLINE

2. On June 11, 2015, the Board issued Order No. 4061 requiring Respondent to complete six (6) hours of education on the topic of medication errors and five (5) hours of

education on the topic of documentation. Her nursing license was further limited with the requirement to complete an AODA assessment.

3. On August 26, 2015, the Board issued an Order granting full licensure to Respondent.

CURRENT CASE

4. Respondent worked part-time as a contract nurse in an ICU at a medical center located in Rock Hill, South Carolina from March 2020 to July 2020.

5. The Department received notification that Respondent voluntarily surrendered her nursing license in the state of South Carolina.

6. At the time of Respondent's surrender, she was subject to an investigation for alleged professional misconduct.

7. Respondent was alleged to have diverted fentanyl for her personal use and selfinjected the medication during while on duty.

8. An internal investigation found several incidents where Respondent did not document medication administrations and documented wasting bags of fentanyl on three occasions.

9. On July 19, 2021, Respondent agreed to surrender her right to renew her Wisconsin nursing license.

10. In resolution of this matter, Respondent consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Board has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 441.07, and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).

2. By the conduct described in the Findings of Fact, Respondent violated Wis. Admin Code N 7.03(1)(b) by having a license to practice nursing or a nurse licensure compact privilege to practice denied, revoked, suspended, limited, or having the credential holder otherwise disciplined in another state, territory, or country.

3. As a result of the above violations, Respondent is subject to discipline pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 441.07(1g)(b) and (d).

<u>ORDER</u>

1. The attached Stipulation is accepted.

2. The VOLUNTARY SURRENDER by Respondent of her license to practice as a registered nurse in the state of Wisconsin (license no. 144341-30), as well as her right to renew such license is accepted.

3. In the event Respondent petitions the Board for reinstatement of her license to practice as a registered nurse in the state of Wisconsin or applies for another credential in the state of Wisconsin under Wis. Stat. chs. 440 through 480, Respondent shall pay the costs of this matter in the amount of \$303.00, before any petition or application for a credential will be considered by the applicable board or Department.

4. In the event Respondent petitions the Board for reinstatement as a registered nurse, the Board may enter an order denying such application without further notice or hearing. Whether to grant a license and whether to impose any limitations or restrictions on any license granted shall be in the sole discretion of the Board and such decision is not reviewable.

Melissa M. Collins, R.N. (Respondent) and the Division of Legal Services and Compliance, Department of Safety and Professional Services stipulate as follows:

1. This Stipulation is entered into as a result of a pending investigation by the Division of Legal Services and Compliance. Respondent consents to the resolution of this investigation by Stipulation.

2. Respondent understands that by signing this Stipulation, Respondent voluntarily and knowingly waives the following rights:

- the right to a hearing on the allegations against Respondent, at which time the State has the burden of proving those allegations by a preponderance of the evidence;
- the right to confront and cross-examine the witnesses against Respondent;
- the right to call witnesses on Respondent's behalf and to compel their attendance by subpoena;
- the right to testify on Respondent's own behalf;
- the right to file objections to any proposed decision and to present briefs or oral arguments to the officials who are to render the final decision;
- the right to petition for rehearing; and
- all other applicable rights afforded to Respondent under the United States Constitution, the Wisconsin Constitution, the Wisconsin Statutes, the Wisconsin Administrative Code, and other provisions of state or federal law.

3. Respondent is aware of Respondent's right to seek legal representation and has been provided an opportunity to obtain legal counsel before signing this Stipulation.

4. Respondent agrees to the adoption of the attached Final Decision and Order by the Wisconsin Board of Nursing (Board). The parties to the Stipulation consent to the entry of the attached Final Decision and Order without further notice, pleading, appearance or consent of the parties. Respondent waives all rights to any appeal of the Board's order, if adopted in the form as attached.

5. If the terms of this Stipulation are not acceptable to the Board the parties shall not be bound by the contents of this Stipulation, and the matter shall then be returned to the Division
