PROCEDURAL HISTORY

This matter comes before the Wisconsin Cosmetology Examining Board (Board) as two citations to which Respondents have made no timely response. Based on the record in this case, the Board adopts as its Final Decision in this matter the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent Tia J. Hunter (Birth Year 1984) is licensed in the state of Wisconsin as a cosmetologist, having credential number 82578-82, first issued on January 26, 2004 and current through March 31, 2023. Respondent's most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services (Department) is in Madison, Wisconsin 53715.

2. Respondent Honeycomb Salon Collective is licensed in the state of Wisconsin as a cosmetology establishment, having credential number 41770-80, first issued on December 8, 2014 and current through March 31, 2023. Respondent's most recent address on file with the Department is in Madison, Wisconsin 53715.

3. Respondent Tia J. Hunter is identified in Department records as the responsible licensee for Honeycomb Salon Collective.

4. On May 23, 2019, the Department received a complaint alleging that Respondents were operating with expired credentials. The Division of Legal Services and Compliance (DLSC) subsequently opened Case Number 19 BAC 046 for investigation.

5. Following an inspection on August 7, 2019, a Division of Legal Services and Compliance (Division) investigator issued two citations to Respondents for violating Wis. Admin. Code §§ Cos 2.04(1), Cos 2.045(1), and Cos 3.01(1).¹ Service was accomplished by mail. True and correct copies of these citations are attached as Exhibit A and are incorporated herein by reference.

6. Respondents have not paid the citations that were issued to Respondents on September 27, 2021.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Wisconsin Cosmetology Examining Board has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 454.15.

2. Respondents violated Wis. Admin. Code § Cos 2.04(1) by assisting or participating in the unauthorized or unlicensed practice of cosmetology.

3. Respondents violated Wis. Admin. Code § Cos 3.01(1) and 2.045(1) by practicing cosmetology outside the confines of a licensed establishment.

4. As a result, Respondents are subject to discipline pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 454.15(2)(i) and (3).

5. Respondents are in default pursuant to Wis. Admin. Code § Cos 10.07(1) for failing to make a deposit or otherwise respond to the citations in a timely fashion.

6. Pursuant to Wis. Admin. Code $\$ Cos 10.07(1), the Board has the authority to issue an order of default against Respondents for the amount identified in the citations without further proceedings.

¹ All references to Wis. Admin. Code ch. Cos are to the Code as it existed at the time of the incident.

ORDER

Respondents are in DEFAULT and shall pay to the Wisconsin Department of 1. Safety and Professional Services a total forfeiture in the amount of \$500 within thirty (30) days from the date of this Order.
