On February 3, 2022, the Wisconsin Chiropractic Examining Board issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") requiring Respondent to complete three (3) hours of education on "standard of care" and three (3) hours on "high intensity laser treatments and patient safety" within ninety (90) days. Respondent was also required to pay \$1,717.00 in costs of the proceeding within ninety (90) days.

Based upon the information of record, which includes proof that Respondent has now completed the education and submitted the payment for costs in full, the following is entered:

1. Respondent's Chiropractic license (#2183-12) is hereby returned to full, unrestricted status.
2. All limitations and encumbrances upon Respondent's credential are removed.
