The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final disposition of this matter, subject to the approval of the Social Worker Section of the Marriage and Family Therapy, Professional Counseling and Social Work Examining Board (Section). The Section has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Section in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Jake T. Prichard, S.W. (Licensee), (Year of Birth 1995) is certified in the state of Wisconsin to practice social work, having certificate number 12847-120, first issued on August 30, 2018 and current through February 28, 2021. Licensee's most recent address on file with the

¹ Licensee's license was set to expire February 28, 2021, and it does not appear he has attempted to renew. However, due to Governor Evers' Emergency Order 2, all health care provider licenses or certificates will not expire until thirty days after Emergency Order 2 is no longer in effect. Therefore, Licensee's license remains "Active" despite the fact he has not renewed his license.

Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services (Department) is in Stevens Point, Wisconsin 54481.

- 2. At all times relevant to this matter, Licensee was employed as a social worker at a county agency (Agency) located in Marshfield, Wisconsin.
- 3. On August 28, 2019, Licensee incorrectly completed a Confirming Safe Environments (CSE) assessment by documenting that he conducted a background check on an out of home placement provider and indicated that no adult in the home had a criminal background. In fact, Licensee did not conduct a criminal background check of the adults in the home and one of the adults had an extensive criminal background history including Operating with a PAC 6th, disorderly conduct, battery, possession of THC, and child neglect charges.
- 4. On September 18, 2019, Licensee did not assess an out of home placement in accordance with CSE standards when he failed to complete a thorough inspection of the home to assess for safety. Licensee did not complete the home visit and inspection until over one year later on October 7, 2020.
- 5. Licensee explained that during his time at the Agency that any documentation errors he made were due to the fact that he had not been properly trained to complete CSE assessments and documentation and he had not been properly supervised.
 - 6. Licensee was terminated from his position as a social worker on November 1, 2019.
- 7. In resolution of this matter, Licensee consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Wisconsin Social Worker Section of the Marriage and Family Therapy, Professional Counseling and Social Work Examining Board is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).

ORDER

- 1. The attached Stipulation is accepted.
- 2. Within six (6) months of the date of this Order, Licensee shall, at their own expense, take and successfully complete eight (8) hours of education on the topic of proper documentation and record keeping as follows:
 - a. Each course attended in satisfaction of this Order must be pre-approved by the Section or its designee. Licensee shall be responsible for locating course(s) satisfactory to the Section and for obtaining the required approval of the course(s) from the Section or its designee. Licensee must take and pass any exam offered for the course(s).

- b. Licensee shall submit proof of successful completion of the education in the form of verification from the institution providing the education to the Department Monitor at the address stated below. None of the education completed pursuant to this requirement may be used to satisfy any continuing education requirements that have been or may be instituted by the Section or Department and may not be used in any future attempt to upgrade a credential.
- c. The Section's monitoring liaison may change the number of credit hours and/or education topics in response to a request from Licensee. The monitoring liaison may consider the topic availability and/or hours of education when determining if a change to the ordered education should occur.

Jake T. Prichard, S.W. (Licensee) and the Division of Legal Services and Compliance, Department of Safety and Professional Services stipulate as follows:

- 1. This Stipulation is entered into as a result of a pending investigation by the Division of Legal Services and Compliance. Licensee consents to the resolution of this investigation by Stipulation.
- 2. Licensee understands that by signing this Stipulation, Licensee voluntarily and knowingly waives the following rights:
 - the right to a hearing on the allegations against Licensee, at which time the State has the burden of proving those allegations by a preponderance of the evidence;
 - the right to confront and cross-examine the witnesses against Licensee;
 - the right to call witnesses on Licensee's behalf and to compel their attendance by subpoena;
 - the right to testify on Licensee's own behalf;
 - the right to file objections to any proposed decision and to present briefs or oral arguments to the officials who are to render the final decision;
 - the right to petition for rehearing; and
 - all other applicable rights afforded to Licensee under the United States Constitution, the Wisconsin Constitution, the Wisconsin Statutes, the Wisconsin Administrative Code, and other provisions of state or federal law.
- 3. Licensee is aware of Licensee's right to seek legal representation and has been provided an opportunity to obtain legal counsel before signing this Stipulation.
- 4. Licensee agrees to the adoption of the attached Final Decision and Order by the Wisconsin Social Worker Section of the Marriage and Family Therapy, Professional Counseling and Social Work Examining Board (Section). The parties to the Stipulation consent to the entry of the attached Final Decision and Order without further notice, pleading, appearance or consent of the parties. Licensee waives all rights to any appeal of the Section's order, if adopted in the form as attached.

- 5. If the terms of this Stipulation are not acceptable to the Section the parties shall not be bound by the contents of this Stipulation, and the matter shall then be returned to the Division of Legal Services and Compliance for further proceedings. In the event that the Stipulation is not accepted by the Section, the parties agree not to contend that the Section has been prejudiced or biased in any manner by the consideration of this attempted resolution.
- 6. The parties to this Stipulation agree that the attorney or other agent for the Division of Legal Services and Compliance and any member of the Section ever assigned as an advisor in this investigation may appear before the Section in open or closed session, without the presence of Licensee, for purposes of speaking in support of this agreement and answering questions that any member of the Section may have in connection with deliberations on the Stipulation. Additionally, any such advisor may vote on whether the Section should accept this Stipulation and issue the attached Final Decision and Order.
- 7. Licensee is informed that should the Section adopt this Stipulation, the Section's Final Decision and Order is a public record and will be published in accordance with standard Department procedure.
- 8. The Division of Legal Services and Compliance joins Licensee in recommending the Section adopt this Stipulation and issue the attached Final Decision and Order.
