The parties in these matters agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final disposition of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board of Nursing (Board). The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in these matters adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Order.

#### FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Both above-referenced cases share the same facts. DLSC Case No. 20 NUR 612 was opened for investigation first. 21 NUR 148 was opened during that investigation in response to a second complaint containing additional information, but identical alleged violations. The two cases are being combined for the purposes of this Final Decision and Order.

2. Respondent Karla R. Green, L.P.N., (Year of Birth 1980) is licensed in the state of Wisconsin as a licensed practical nurse, with multistate privileges pursuant to the Enhanced Nurse Licensure Compact (Compact), having license number 307563-31, first issued on July 12, 2006 and current through April 30, 2023. Respondent's most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services (Department) is in Milwaukee, Wisconsin 53210.

3. At all times relevant to these proceedings, Respondent was employed as a licensed practical nurse at a nursing home in Glendale, Wisconsin (Facility).

4. On October 12, 2020, a 76-year-old female patient (Patient A) was admitted to the Facility. Patient A was her own decisionmaker and elected to have a full code advanced directive, meaning resuscitation procedures were to be provided if her heart stopped or she stopped breathing. This full code status was documented in Patient A's facility records and available to all nursing staff.

5. On the evening of November 30, 2020, a CNA found Patient A unresponsive and notified Respondent.

6. Respondent responded to Patient A's room, and observed that Patient A had no pulse and was not breathing. Respondent moved the patient to a different room and notified the nursing supervisor,<sup>1</sup> but did not check Patient A's code status, did not call 911, and did not begin CPR.

7. In resolution of these matters, Respondent consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

### CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Board has jurisdiction to act in these matters pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 441.07 and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).

2. By the conduct described in the Findings of Fact, Respondent failed to treat within the meaning of Wis. Admin. Code N 7.03(6)(j).

3. By the conduct described in the Findings of Fact, Respondent failed to execute a medical order within the meaning of Wis. Admin. Code N 7.03(6)(o).

4. As a result of the above conduct, Respondent is subject to discipline pursuant to Wis. Stat. 441.07(1g)(b) and (d) and Wis. Admin. Code N 7.03.

### <u>ORDER</u>

1. The attached Stipulation is accepted.

2. Respondent is REPRIMANDED.

3. The licensed practical nurse license issued to Respondent (license number 307563-31), and privilege to practice in Wisconsin pursuant to the Enhanced Nurse Licensure Compact, are LIMITED as follows:

a. Within 90 days of the date of this Order, Respondent shall at her own expense, successfully complete four hours of education on the topic of advanced directives

and/or care planning offered by a provider pre-approved by the Board's monitoring liaison, including taking and passing any exam offered for the courses.

- b. Respondent shall submit proof of successful completion of the education in the form of verification from the institution providing the education to the Department Monitor at the address stated below. None of the education completed pursuant to this requirement may be used to satisfy any continuing education requirements that have been or may be instituted by the Board or Department, and also may not be used in future attempts to upgrade a credential in Wisconsin.
- c. The Board's monitoring liaison may change the number of credit hours and/or education topics in response to a request from Respondent. The monitoring liaison may consider the topic availability and/or hours of education when determining if a change to the ordered education should occur.
- d. This limitation shall be removed from Respondent's license after satisfying the Board or its designee that Respondent has successfully completed all the ordered education.

4. Within 90 days from the date of this Order, Respondent shall pay COSTS of this matter in the amount of \$892.00.

5. Any requests, petitions, payments of costs (made payable to Department of Safety and Professional Services), and other information required by this Order shall be submitted to:

6. Pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 441.51(5)(b), Respondent's multistate licensure privilege to practice in all Compact states other than Wisconsin is deactivated while Respondent's license is encumbered by the terms of this Order.

7. In the event Respondent violates any term of this Order, Respondent's license (307563-31), or Respondent's right to renew her license, may, in the discretion of the Board or its designee, be SUSPENDED, without further notice or hearing, until Respondent has complied with the terms of the Order. The Board may, in addition and/or in the alternative refer any violation of this Order to the Division of Legal Services and Compliance for further investigation and action.

8. This Order is effective on the date of its signing.

#### STIPULATION

**ORDER 00079**20

Division of Legal Services and Compliance Case Nos. 20 NUR 612 and 21 NUR 148

Respondent Karla R. Green, L.P.N., and the Division of Legal Services and Compliance, Department of Safety and Professional Services stipulate as follows:

1. This Stipulation is entered into as a result of pending investigations by the Division of Legal Services and Compliance. Respondent consents to the resolution of these investigations by Stipulation.

2. Respondent understands that by signing this Stipulation, Respondent voluntarily and knowingly waives the following rights:

- the right to a hearing on the allegations against Respondent, at which time the State has the burden of proving those allegations by a preponderance of the evidence;
- the right to confront and cross-examine the witnesses against Respondent;
- the right to call witnesses on Respondent's behalf and to compel their attendance by subpoena;
- the right to testify on Respondent's own behalf;
- the right to file objections to any proposed decision and to present briefs or oral arguments to the officials who are to render the final decision;
- the right to petition for rehearing; and
- all other applicable rights afforded to Respondent under the United States Constitution, the Wisconsin Constitution, the Wisconsin Statutes, the Wisconsin Administrative Code, and other provisions of state or federal law.

3. Respondent is aware of Respondent's right to seek legal representation and has been provided an opportunity to obtain legal counsel before signing this Stipulation.

4. Respondent agrees to the adoption of the attached Final Decision and Order by the Wisconsin Board of Nursing (Board). The parties to the Stipulation consent to the entry of the attached Final Decision and Order without further notice, pleading, appearance or consent of the parties. Respondent waives all rights to any appeal of the Board's order, if adopted in the form as attached.

5. If the terms of this Stipulation are not acceptable to the Board, the parties shall not be bound by the contents of this Stipulation, and the matters shall then be returned to the Division

of Legal Services and Compliance for further proceedings. In the event that the Stipulation is not accepted by the Board, the parties agree not to contend that the Board has been prejudiced or biased in any manner by the consideration of this attempted resolution.

6. The parties to this Stipulation agree that the attorney or other agent for the Division of Legal Services and Compliance and any member of the Board ever assigned as an advisor in this investigation may appear before the Board in open or closed session, without the presence of Respondent, for purposes of speaking in support of this agreement and answering questions that any member of the Board may have in connection with deliberations on the Stipulation. Additionally, any such advisor may vote on whether the Board should accept this Stipulation and issue the attached Final Decision and Order.

7. Respondent is informed that should the Board adopt this Stipulation, the Board's Final Decision and Order is a public record and will be published in accordance with standard Department procedure.

8. The Division of Legal Services and Compliance joins Respondent in recommending the Board adopt this Stipulation and issue the attached Final Decision and Order.
