The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final disposition of this matter, subject to the approval of the Medical Examining Board (Board). The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Salvador Cenicerros, M.D. (Respondent), (Year of Birth 1948) is licensed in the state of Wisconsin to practice medicine and surgery having license number 39501-20, first issued on December 19, 1997, and with registration current through October 31, 2021.¹ Respondent's most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services (Department) is in Springfield, Missouri 65810.

¹ Respondent's license was set to expire on October 31, 2021, and it does not appear he has attempted to renew. However, due to 2021 Wisconsin Act 10, all health care provider credentials will not expire until thirty days after the end of the declared national emergency. Therefore, Respondent's license remains active despite the fact he has not completed any of the renewal requirements as of the date of this Final Decision and Order.

2. At all times relevant to this proceeding, Respondent practiced as a physician in Springfield, Missouri.

3. On February 22, 2022, the Missouri Board of Registration for the Healing Arts (Missouri Board) issued a disciplinary order (Missouri Order) accepting Respondent's surrender of his medical license.

4. The Missouri Order found that Respondent committed unprofessional conduct by failing to maintain adequate medical records, failing to furnish medical records in a timely manner, engaging in conduct/practice which is or might be harmful/dangerous to the health of the patient or public, and violating rules pertaining to prescribing or dispensing of controlled substances.

5. In resolution of this matter, Respondent consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Board has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 448.02(3) and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).

2. By the conduct described in the Findings of Fact, Respondent engaged in unprofessional conduct as defined in Wis. Admin. Code § Med 10.03(3)(c) by having any credential pertaining to the practice of medicine and surgery or any act constituting the practice of medicine and surgery become subject to adverse determination by any agency of this or another state, or by any federal agency or authority.

3. As a result of the above violations, Respondent is subject to discipline pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 448.02(3).

ORDER

1. The attached Stipulation is accepted.

2. The SURRENDER by Respondent of his license and registration to practice medicine and surgery in the state of Wisconsin (license no. 39501-20), as well as his right to renew such license and registration, is accepted.

3. In the event Respondent petitions the Board for reinstatement of his license and registration to practice medicine and surgery in the state of Wisconsin or applies for another credential in the state of Wisconsin under Wis. Stat. chs. 440 through 480, Respondent shall pay the costs of this matter in the amount of \$353.00, before any petition or application for a credential will be considered by the applicable board or Department.

4. In the event Respondent petitions the Board for reinstatement as a physician, the Board may enter an order denying such application without further notice or hearing. Whether to grant a license and registration and whether to impose any limitations or restrictions on any license and registration granted shall be in the sole discretion of the Board and such decision is not reviewable.

STIPULATION

ORDER 0007938

Division of Legal Services and Compliance Case No. 22 MED 112

Salvador Cenicerros, M.D. (Respondent), and the Division of Legal Services and Compliance, Department of Safety and Professional Services, stipulate as follows:

1. This Stipulation is entered into as a result of a pending investigation by the Division of Legal Services and Compliance. Respondent consents to the resolution of this investigation by Stipulation.

2. Respondent understands that by signing this Stipulation, Respondent voluntarily and knowingly waives the following rights:

- the right to a hearing on the allegations against Respondent, at which time the State has the burden of proving those allegations by a preponderance of the evidence;
- the right to confront and cross-examine the witnesses against Respondent;
- the right to call witnesses on Respondent's behalf and to compel their attendance by subpoena;
- the right to testify on Respondent's own behalf;
- the right to file objections to any proposed decision and to present briefs or oral arguments to the officials who are to render the final decision;
- the right to petition for rehearing; and
- all other applicable rights afforded to Respondent under the United States Constitution, the Wisconsin Constitution, the Wisconsin Statutes, the Wisconsin Administrative Code, and other provisions of state or federal law.

3. Respondent is aware of Respondent's right to seek legal representation and has been provided an opportunity to obtain legal counsel before signing this Stipulation.

4. Respondent agrees to the adoption of the attached Final Decision and Order by the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board (Board). The parties to the Stipulation consent to the entry of the attached Final Decision and Order without further notice, pleading, appearance or consent of the parties. Respondent waives all rights to any appeal of the Board's order, if adopted in the form as attached.

5. If the terms of this Stipulation are not acceptable to the Board, the parties shall not be bound by the contents of this Stipulation, and the matter shall then be returned to the Division

8. 11. The entire agreement between the parties shall be contained in this Agreement and no other terms, conditions, policies or procedures shall be applicable to the relationship between the parties.

Additionally, any such advisor may vote on whether the Board should accept this Stipulation and issue the attached Final Decision and Order.

7. Respondent is informed that should the Board adopt this Stipulation, the Board's Final Decision and Order is a public record and will be published in accordance with standard Department procedure.

8. Respondent is further informed that should the Board adopt this Stipulation, the Board's Final Decision and Order will be reported as required by the National Practitioner Databank (NPDB) Guidebook and as otherwise required by any licensure compact or any other state or federal law.

9. The Division of Legal Services and Compliance joins Respondent in recommending the Board adopt this Stipulation and issue the attached Final Decision and Order.
