
On April 28, 2022, the Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's license to practice pharmacy. Respondent was required to complete education on the topics of Prescription Drug Monitoring Program (PDMP) and Pharmacy Practice Law pursuant to the terms of the Order.
