
On June 9, 2022, the Wisconsin Real Estate Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's registered nurse license. Respondent was required to complete three (3) hours of education on the topic of nursing ethics pursuant to the terms of the Order.
