On August 10, 2022, the Wisconsin Physical Therapy Examining Board issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's license to practice as a physical therapy assistant for three (3) months and requiring Respondent to complete fifteen (15) hours of education on the topic of "appropriate boundaries between health care professionals and patients/clients" within ninety (90) days and to pay \$527.00 in costs of the proceeding within 90 days.

Based upon the information of record, which includes proof that Respondent has now completed the education and submitted the payment for costs in full, the following is entered:

ORDER

1. Respondent's license to practice as a physical therapy assistant (license no. 640-19) is returned to full, unrestricted status.
2. All limitations and encumbrances upon Respondent's credential are removed.
3. This order is effective the date of its signing.
