On August 11, 2022, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's license to practice as a registered nurse for an indefinite period. The suspension may be stayed upon Respondent petitioning and providing proof, which is determined by the Board or its designee to be sufficient, that Respondent is in compliance with the provision of Sections C and D of the Order for a period of at least 30 consecutive days.

The Board designee has considered Respondent's request for an initial stay of suspension. Based upon the information of record, the following is entered:

ORDER

1. The suspension of Respondent's license to practice as a registered nurse (license no. 226677-30) is hereby STAYED.
2. The stay is continuous, contingent upon Respondent's compliance with the terms and conditions of the Order.
