The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final disposition of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board of Nursing (Board). The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Kristine A. Stellmach, L.P.N. (Respondent), (Year of Birth 1966) is licensed in the state of Wisconsin as a licensed practical nurse, with multistate privileges pursuant to the Nurse Licensure Compact (Compact) having license number 320073-31, first issued on December 21, 2015 and current through April 30, 2023. Respondent's most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services (Department) is in Milwaukee, Wisconsin 53219.
- 2. At all times relevant to this proceeding, Respondent worked as a licensed practical nurse at a facility located in Greenfield, Wisconsin (Facility).

- 3. On December 15, 2021, Respondent reported that Resident A (male born in 1962) was lashing out, belligerent, yelling, and was disrespectful to the staff members. Respondent discussed prescribing Ativan with Resident A's treating physician (Doctor B).
- 4. On December 23, 2021, Resident A appeared over sedated. The Facility reviewed Resident A's medication orders and found a discrepancy between the Medication Administration Record (MAR) and the physician order sent to the pharmacy.
- 5. The Facility investigated and determined that Respondent made a transcription error in the medication order from Doctor B. Respondent recorded Resident A's order in the MAR as 0.5 mg Ativan every eight hours, however, the order sent to the pharmacy by Doctor B was 0.5 mg Ativan every 12 hours as needed.
- 6. On December 24, 2021, Respondent received education from the Facility on methods to avoid transcription errors, including the use of verbal read back to confirm telephone orders.
- 7. In resolution of this matter, Respondent consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Board has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 441.07 and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).
- 2. By the conduct described in the Findings of Fact, Respondent engaged in unsafe practice or substandard care by failing to perform nursing with reasonable skill and safety within the meaning of Wis. Admin. Code § N 7.03(6)(a).
- 3. By the conduct described in the Findings of Fact, Respondent engaged in unsafe practice or substandard care by departing from or failing to conform to the minimal standards of acceptable nursing practice that may create unnecessary risk or danger to a patient's life, health, or safety within the meaning of Wis. Admin. Code § N 7.03(6)(c).
- 4. As a result of the above conduct, Respondent is subject to discipline pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 441.07(1g)(b) and (d), and Wis. Admin. Code § N 7.03.

<u>ORDER</u>

- 1. The attached Stipulation is accepted.
- 2. Respondent is REPRIMANDED.
- 3. The Board accepts the education referenced in Findings of Fact paragraph No. 6 in satisfaction of continuing education the Board would otherwise require.
- 4. Within ninety (90) days from the date of this Order, Respondent shall pay COSTS of this matter in the amount of \$559.00.

5. Any requests, petitions, payments of costs (made payable to Department of Safety and Professional Services), and other information required by this Order shall be submitted to:

The Board may, in addition and/or in the alternative refer any violation of this Order to the Division of Legal Services and Compliance for further investigation and action.
 - 7. This Order is effective on the date of its signing.

Respondent Kristine A. Stellmach, L.P.N., and the Division of Legal Services and Compliance, Department of Safety and Professional Services, stipulate as follows:

- 1. This Stipulation is entered into as a result of a pending investigation by the Division of Legal Services and Compliance. Respondent consents to the resolution of this investigation by Stipulation.
- 2. Respondent understands that by signing this Stipulation, Respondent voluntarily and knowingly waives the following rights:
 - the right to a hearing on the allegations against Respondent, at which time the State has the burden of proving those allegations by a preponderance of the evidence;
 - the right to confront and cross-examine the witnesses against Respondent;
 - the right to call witnesses on Respondent's behalf and to compel their attendance by subpoena;
 - the right to testify on Respondent's own behalf;
 - the right to file objections to any proposed decision and to present briefs or oral arguments to the officials who are to render the final decision;
 - the right to petition for rehearing; and
 - all other applicable rights afforded to Respondent under the United States Constitution, the Wisconsin Constitution, the Wisconsin Statutes, the Wisconsin Administrative Code, and other provisions of state or federal law.
- 3. Respondent is aware of Respondent's right to seek legal representation and has been provided an opportunity to obtain legal counsel before signing this Stipulation.
- 4. Respondent agrees to the adoption of the attached Final Decision and Order by the Wisconsin Board of Nursing (Board). The parties to the Stipulation consent to the entry of the attached Final Decision and Order without further notice, pleading, appearance or consent of the parties. Respondent waives all rights to any appeal of the Board's order, if adopted in the form as attached.
- 5. If the terms of this Stipulation are not acceptable to the Board, the parties shall not be bound by the contents of this Stipulation, and the matter shall then be returned to the Division

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of Legal Services and Compliance for further proceedings. - 8. Respondent is further informed that should the Board adopt this Stipulation, the Board's Final Decision and Order will be reported as required by the National Practitioner Databank (NPDB) Guidebook and as otherwise required by any licensure compact or any other state or federal law.
- The Division of Legal Services and Compliance joins Respondent in recommending the Board adopt this Stipulation and issue the attached Final Decision and Order.
