On September 21, 2017, the Wisconsin Pharmacy Examining Board ("Board") issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") suspending Respondent's license to practice pharmacy for an indefinite period. Respondent has been granted a stay of suspension and his license is currently limited with certain terms and conditions.

On April 27, 2023, the Board considered Respondent's request for the reduction in drug screens, reduction of AA/NA meetings to once per week, and the termination of the drug and alcohol (AODA) treatment requirement. Based upon the information of record, the Board finds and makes the following:

ORDER

1. Respondent's request for the termination of the drug and alcohol (AODA) treatment requirement is hereby GRANTED and the Order is modified to require participation in mental health and wellness therapy by a Board approved treater. Provisions C.2.- C.5. remain in full force and effect.
2. Respondent's request for a reduction in drug screens is hereby DENIED.
3. Respondent's request for a reduction of AA/NA meeting to once per week is hereby DENIED.
4. All other terms and conditions of the Order not otherwise modified remain in full force and effect.
5. This order is effective the date of its signing.
