On August 14, 2023, the Wisconsin Board of Nursing Monitoring Liaison ("Liaison") considered Respondent's request to surrender her practical nursing license, which is currently limited pursuant to the Final Decision and Order issued on January 14, 2021. Based upon the information of record, the Board, through its designee, finds and makes the following:

#### **ORDER**

- 1. The surrender of Respondent's practical nursing license (#311376-31) is hereby accepted.
- 2. Respondent may petition for reinstatement of her license; however, no such petition shall occur earlier than one (1) year from the date of this order.
- 3. In the event that Respondent re-applies for licensure as a practical nurse in the future, the Respondent's application shall be in accordance with Wis. Admin. Code § N 2.41, including evidence of completion of the disciplinary requirements, and evidence of rehabilitation or change in circumstances warranting reinstatement. Additionally, if the license has not been active within five (5) years, evidence of completion of the requirements in Wis. Admin. Code §. N 2.40(3).
- 4. After review of the evidence provided in section 3, the Board may enter an order denying such application or an order imposing limitations, including those limitations contained in Order 7163, without further notice or hearing.
- 5. This order is effective the date of its signing.
