The parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final disposition of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board of Nursing (Board). The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable.

Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Respondent Amanda J. Macedo, R.N., (Year of Birth 1982) is licensed in the state of Wisconsin as a licensed practical nurse, having license number 318777-31, first issued on September 12, 2014 and current through April 30, 2023. Respondent's most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services (Department) is in Sheboygan, Wisconsin 53083.

2. At all times relevant to this proceeding, Respondent was employed as a licensed practical nurse at a nursing home and rehabilitation facility located in Sheboygan, Wisconsin (Facility).

3. On April 7, 2021, the Department's Division of Legal Services and Compliance received a complaint alleging that Respondent was diverting narcotics from Facility patients.

4. On September 14, 2021, Respondent was charged with four counts of felony Medical Assistance Fraud and six counts of felony Acquiring Possession of a Controlled Substance by Misrepresentation, in violation of Wis. Stats. §§ 946.91(2)(a) and 961.43(1)(a) respectively, in Sheboygan County Circuit Court Case Number 2021CF000651. On November 9, 2021, the four counts of felony Medical Assistance Fraud were dismissed.

5. On January 13, 2022, the Board issued Interim Order No. 0007772 limiting Respondent's license during the pendency of Case No. 21 NUR 202.

6. On June 17, 2022, Respondent was convicted of two counts of Obtain Controlled Substance by Fraud, a felony, in violation of Wis. Stat. § 961.43(1)(a), in Sheboygan County Circuit Court Case No. 2021CF000651. The other four counts of Obtain Controlled Substance by Fraud were dismissed but read in for purposes of sentencing.

7. Respondent was fined and sentenced to four months in jail with Huber privileges, 30 days stayed, to begin on August 22, 2022.

8. On October 13, 2022, the Board suspended Respondent's license for failure to comply with the terms and conditions of Interim Order No. 0007772.

9. In resolution of this matter, Respondent consents to the entry of the following Conclusions of Law and Order.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. The Board has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 441.07, and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).

2. By the conduct described in the Findings of Fact, Respondent violated or aided and abetted a violation of any law substantially related to the practice of nursing or was convicted of any crime substantially related to the practice of nursing, within the meaning of Wis. Admin. Code § N 7.03(2).

3. As a result of the above violation, Respondent is subject to discipline pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 441.07(1g)(b) and (d), and Wis. Admin. Code § N 7.03.

ORDER

1. The attached Stipulation is accepted.

2. The VOLUNTARY SURRENDER by Respondent of her license to practice as a licensed practical nurse in the state of Wisconsin (license no. 318777-31), as well as her right to renew such license, is accepted.

3. In the event Respondent petitions the Board for reinstatement of her license to practice as a licensed practical nurse in the state of Wisconsin or applies for another credential in the state of Wisconsin under Wis. Stat. chs. 440 through 480, Respondent shall pay the costs of this matter in the amount of \$2,671.00, before any petition or application for a credential will be considered by the applicable board or Department.

4. In the event Respondent petitions the Board for reinstatement as a licensed practical nurse, the Board may enter an order denying such application without further notice or hearing. Whether to grant a license and whether to impose any limitations or restrictions on any license granted shall be in the sole discretion of the Board and such decision is not reviewable.

Respondent Amanda J. Macedo, L.P.N., and the Division of Legal Services and Compliance, Department of Safety and Professional Services, stipulate as follows:

1. This Stipulation is entered into as a result of a pending investigation by the Division of Legal Services and Compliance. Respondent consents to the resolution of this investigation by Stipulation.

2. Respondent understands that by signing this Stipulation, Respondent voluntarily and knowingly waives the following rights:

- the right to a hearing on the allegations against Respondent, at which time the State has the burden of proving those allegations by a preponderance of the evidence;
- the right to confront and cross-examine the witnesses against Respondent;
- the right to call witnesses on Respondent's behalf and to compel their attendance by subpoena;
- the right to testify on Respondent's own behalf;
- the right to file objections to any proposed decision and to present briefs or oral arguments to the officials who are to render the final decision;
- the right to petition for rehearing; and
- all other applicable rights afforded to Respondent under the United States Constitution, the Wisconsin Constitution, the Wisconsin Statutes, the Wisconsin Administrative Code, and other provisions of state or federal law.

3. Respondent is aware of Respondent's right to seek legal representation and has been provided an opportunity to obtain legal counsel before signing this Stipulation.

4. Respondent agrees to the adoption of the attached Final Decision and Order by the Wisconsin Board of Nursing (Board). The parties to the Stipulation consent to the entry of the attached Final Decision and Order without further notice, pleading, appearance or consent of the parties. Respondent waives all rights to any appeal of the Board's order, if adopted in the form as attached.

5. If the terms of this Stipulation are not acceptable to the Board, the parties shall not be bound by the contents of this Stipulation, and the matter shall then be returned to the Division

of Legal Services and Compliance for further proceedings. In the event that the Stipulation is not accepted by the Board, the parties agree not to contend that the Board has been prejudiced or biased in any manner by the consideration of this attempted resolution.


6. The parties to this Stipulation agree that the attorney or other agent for the Division of Legal Services and Compliance and any member of the Board ever assigned as an advisor in this investigation may appear before the Board in open or closed session, without the presence of Respondent, for purposes of speaking in support of this agreement and answering questions that any member of the Board may have in connection with deliberations on the Stipulation. Additionally, any such advisor may vote on whether the Board should accept this Stipulation and issue the attached Final Decision and Order.

7. Respondent is informed that should the Board adopt this Stipulation, the Board's Final Decision and Order is a public record and will be published in accordance with standard Department procedure.

8. Respondent is further informed that should the Board adopt this Stipulation, the Board's Final Decision and Order will be reported as required by the National Practitioner Databank (NPDB) Guidebook and as otherwise required by any licensure compact or any other state or federal law.

9. The Division of Legal Services and Compliance joins Respondent in recommending the Board adopt this Stipulation and issue the attached Final Decision and Order.
