On September 21, 2022, the Department of Safety and Professional Services (Department) issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") limiting Respondent's clinical substance abuse counselor license with certain terms and conditions including, but not limited to, completion of an assessment by an approved mental health provider experienced in evaluating health care practitioners' fitness for duty. The Order further states that Respondent's license shall be limited in a manner to address any concerns the Board has with the conduct set out in the Order's findings of fact and to address any recommendations resulting from the assessment.

The Department reviewed and accepted the report resulting from Respondent's fitness for duty assessment. Based on the assessor's recommendations, the following is entered:

ORDER

- 1. Respondent's clinical substance abuse counselor license (#16426-132) is hereby SUSPENDED for an indefinite period.
- 2. The suspension of Respondent's clinical substance abuse counselor license may be stayed upon the Respondent petitioning the Section and providing proof, which determined by the Section or its designee to be sufficient, that Respondent is in compliance with the below provisions:
 - a. Respondent shall enter into, and shall continue, psychotherapy, at Respondent's expense, with a therapist approved by the Section or its designee, to address specific treatment goals contained within the fitness to practice assessment completed by Dr. Dennis White, with quarterly reports to the Section, or its designee by the approved therapist. Upon recommendation from the approved therapist, Respondent may petition that the therapy can be terminated.
 - b. Respondent shall take a pre-approved 4 hour course in clinical time management.

- c. Respondent shall take a pre-approved 4 hour course in clinical record-keeping.
- d. Should Respondent's suspension be stayed, the requirements for psychotherapy and quarterly treatment reports will remain in effect. Upon recommendation from the approved therapist, Respondent may petition that therapy can be terminated.
