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Second, the Department finds that you engaged in misconduct in violation of Wis. Admin. Code § SPS 305.10(1)(a)5 as it relates to the work you performed at 439 Shoreland Drive. The Department finds that there is a preponderance of evidence that you failed to complete the job in December 2020 even though the homeowner had communicated with you numerous times to finish the job. The Department is in possession of evidence that shows the homeowner hired


another contractor in early January 2021 to complete the job and that contractor pulled the appropriate permit. The Department finds this to be misconduct and therefore is authorized to discipline your licenses.

The Department allowed you an opportunity to respond. After reviewing the evidence, including your response, the Department found that the complaint has merit and was proved by a preponderance of evidence.

Therefore, based on the foregoing, the Department finds that a total suspension of ten (10) days is appropriate and is entered pursuant to the terms laid out in this document.

You have the right to request a hearing on the suspension by sending a request for hearing to the Department of Safety and Professional Services, Chief Legal Counsel, P.O. Box 7190, Madison, Wisconsin 53707-7190, which must be received by the Department no later than 30 days from the date of mailing of this Notice. Any hearing on the suspension will be held in accordance with the requirements set forth in Wis. Stat. ch. 227.
