
On February 2, 2023, the Wisconsin Real Estate Examining Board (“Board”) issued a Final Decision and Order (“Order”) limiting Respondent’s real estate broker license. Respondent was required to complete one (1) remedial education course on the topic of forms pursuant to the terms of the Order.
