RE: Notification of Automatic and Immediate Suspension of Licensure

Dear Dr. Marks,

This letter is to advise you that on January 30, 2023, the Wisconsin Medical Examining Board (Board) received notification that the Board of Medicine – New Hampshire, Office of Professional Licensure & Certification, issued an Order of Emergency Suspension on January 26, 2023, which suspended your medical license in New Hampshire.

On May 26, 2021, the Board issued your Wisconsin medical license (#1294-320) pursuant to an application through the Interstate Medical Licensure Compact in which you identified New Hampshire as the state of your principal residence/licensure. As a result, pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 448.980(10)(b), your Wisconsin license is automatically and immediately suspended without further action necessary by the Board.
