#### PROCEDURAL HISTORY

A disciplinary proceeding was commended in this matter by the filing of a Notice of Hearing and Complaint on January 17, 2023, with the Wisconsin Department of Administration, Division of Hearings and Appeals (DHA) in DHA Case Number SPS-23-0001. Prior to the hearing on the Complaint, the parties in this matter agree to the terms and conditions of the attached Stipulation as the final disposition of this matter, subject to the approval of the Board of Nursing (Board). The Board has reviewed this Stipulation and considers it acceptable. Accordingly, the Board in this matter adopts the attached Stipulation and makes the following Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Order.

## **FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. Respondent Ambre L. Anderson, R.N., (Year of Birth 1979) is licensed in the state of Wisconsin as a registered nurse, with multistate privileges pursuant to the Nurse Licensure Compact (Compact), having license number 152209-30, first issued on August 4, 2005, and current

through February 28, 2022. Respondent's most recent address on file with the Wisconsin Department of Safety and Professional Services (Department) is in Niagara, Wisconsin 54151.

- 2. At all times relevant to this proceeding, Respondent worked as a registered nurse at a facility located in Michigan (Facility).
- 3. On July 6, 2021, Respondent reported to the Department that on July 1, 2021, she was convicted of Operating While Intoxicated (1<sup>st</sup>) in violation of Michigan Compiled Laws 257.6251-A and two (2) counts of assaulting an officer, resisting arrest, and obstructing arrest in violation of Michigan Compiled Laws 750.81D1[A]. The incident that led to the convictions occurred on February 11, 2021.
- 4. Respondent desires to surrender her Wisconsin license in lieu of proceeding with this investigation and litigation.
- 5. In resolution of this matter, Respondent consents to the entry of the following Conclusion of Law and Order.

# CONCLUSION OF LAW

1. The Board has jurisdiction to act in this matter pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 441.07 and is authorized to enter into the attached Stipulation pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 227.44(5).

#### **ORDER**

- 1. The attached Stipulation is accepted.
- 2. The VOLUNTARY SURRENDER by Respondent of her license to practice nursing in the state of Wisconsin (license no. 152209-30), her right to renew that license, and any multistate privilege to practice in Wisconsin pursuant to the Compact, is accepted.
- 3. In the event Respondent petitions the Board for reinstatement of her license to practice nursing in the state of Wisconsin, the Board may enter an order denying such application without further notice or hearing. Whether to grant a license and whether to impose any limitations or restrictions on any license granted shall be in the sole discretion of the Board and such decision is not reviewable.
- 4. In the event Respondent petitions the Board for reinstatement of her license to practice nursing in the state of Wisconsin or applies for another credential in the state of Wisconsin under Wis. Stat. chs. 440 through 480, Respondent shall pay the costs of this matter in the amount of \$1,282.00, before any petition or application for a credential will be considered by the applicable board or Department.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>1</sup> Due to the Governor's 2020 Emergency Order #2, signed on October 1, 2020, health care provider credentials will not expire for the duration of the federally declared public health emergency. Therefore, Respondent's registered nurse license remains active despite not having completed the renewal requirements as of the date of this Order. Pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 440.08(3), Respondent retains the right to apply to renew her license through February 28, 2027.

STIPULATION

ORDER 0 0 0 8 4 6 3

Division of Legal Services and Compliance Case No. 21 NUR 428

Respondent Ambre L. Anderson, R.N., and the Division of Legal Services and Compliance, Department of Safety and Professional Services, stipulate as follows:

- I. This Stipulation is entered into as a result of a pending investigation by the Division of Legal Services and Compliance. Respondent consents to the resolution of this investigation by Stipulation.
- 2. Respondent understands that by signing this Stipulation, Respondent voluntarily and knowingly waives the following rights:
  - the right to a hearing on the allegations against Respondent, at which time the State has the burden of proving those allegations by a preponderance of the evidence;
  - the right to confront and cross-examine the witnesses against Respondent;
  - the right to call witnesses on Respondent's behalf and to compel their attendance by subpoena;
  - · the right to testify on Respondent's own behalf;
  - the right to file objections to any proposed decision and to present briefs or oral arguments to the officials who are to render the final decision;
  - · the right to petition for rehearing; and
  - all other applicable rights afforded to Respondent under the United States Constitution, the Wiscousin Constitution, the Wisconsin Statutes, the Wisconsin Administrative Code, and other provisions of state or federal law.
- 3. Respondent is aware of Respondent's right to seek legal representation and has been provided an opportunity to obtain legal counsel before signing this Stipulation.
- 4. Respondent agrees to the adoption of the attached Final Decision and Order by the Wisconsin Board of Nursing (Board). The parties to the Stipulation consent to the entry of the attached Final Decision and Order without further notice, pleading, appearance or consent of the parties. Respondent waives all rights to any appeal of the Board's order, if adopted in the form as attached.
- 5. If the terms of this Stipulation are not acceptable to the Board, the parties shall not be bound by the contents of this Stipulation, and the matter shall then be returned to the Division

of Legal Services and Compliance for further proceedings. In the event that the Stipulation is not accepted by the Board, the parties agree not to contend that the Board has been prejudiced or biased in any manner by the consideration of this aftempted resolution.

- 6. The parties to this Stipulation agree that the attorney or other agent for the Division of Legal Services and Compliance and any member of the Board ever assigned as an advisor in this investigation may appear before the Board in open or closed session, without the presence of Respondent, for purposes of speaking in support of this agreement and answering questions that any member of the Board may have in connection with deliberations on the Stipulation. Additionally, any such advisor may vote on whether the Board should accept this Stipulation and issue the attached Final Decision and Order.
- Respondent is informed that should the Board adopt this Stipulation, the Board's Final Decision and Order is a public record and will be published in accordance with standard Department procedure.
- 8. Respondent is further informed that should the Board adopt this Stipulation, the Board's Final Decision and Order will be reported as required by the National Practitioner Databank (NPDB) Guidebook and as otherwise required by any licensure compact or any other state or federal law.
- 9. The Division of Legal Services and Compliance joins Respondent in recommending the Board adopt this Stipulation and issue the attached Final Decision and Order.
