On April 19, 2023, the Wisconsin Professional Counselor Section of the Marriage and Family Therapy, Professional Counseling and Social Work Examining Board issued a Final Decision and Order ("Order") requiring Respondent to complete ten (10) hours of education in "ethics & professional boundaries" within ninety (90) days and pay \$1651.91 in costs of the proceeding within ninety (90) days.
